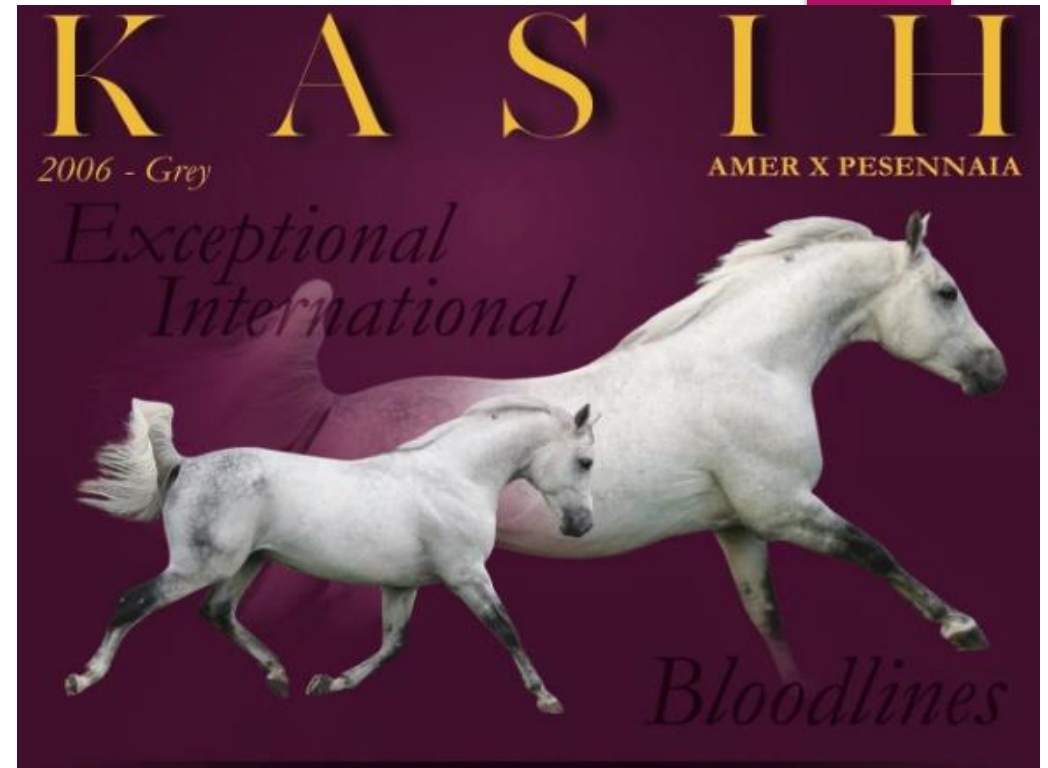

Her dam Stihia was winner of the OAKS, as well as her daughter Valujevka (by Karnaval) and her grand-daughter Valencia (by 2/16(9-1-3)). Her well-known son Sambist was the Russian Derby Winner and a Winner in Europe.

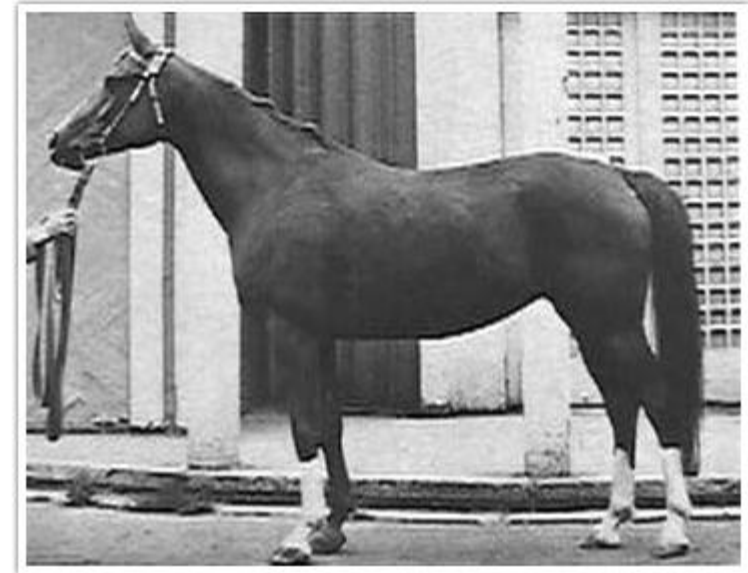

# Additional info

- ▶ The Russian Influence In Performance Arabians (credit Paul Simmons)
- ▶ One of the most influential Russian dam lines of recent years is that of Sapina. As a race horse in her native Russia she won six races including the Russian Oaks before founding her dynasty. Her progeny included Simpatika (won Oaks), Sak, Salsk, Situacia, Setun (dam of race winner Dantist – sire of winners Midnite Dream, Dantes Dream and WA Savannah Sunrise), Saransk – all placed in the Russian Classics and Stihia. The incredible Stihia won five races and was second in the Oaks and the Great Summer Prize. Stihia subsequently became a race broodmare of some distinction producing the phenomenal Sambist – winner of 18 races including the Russian Classics – St Ledger, the Derby, the Comparison Stakes, the Al Nahayan International, the Qatar Long Distance Championship in the UK, Artist – won 6 races in the First Name of USSR and the Friendship of the People, Vesna winner of 2 Russian Classics and dam of Valujevka – won the Oaks. Sleza won and placed in Russia dam of Robbie (by Makzan) won Group 1 in France 2005. Sinka unraced dam of Noble Storm – won in UK and Sing Me A Song (by Tidjani) placed in UK 2005.
